- A-** This broadcasting company televised the 1980 Olympic Winter Games in Lake Placid.
- B-** This Olympic event is a combination of cross-country skiing and rifle shooting.
- C-** What is the name of the ice game that is played with large, heavy stones and brooms?
- D-** This man is responsible for bringing the 1932 Olympic Winter Games to Lake Placid.
- E-** Athletes use this to compete in their sports. For a hockey player it might be a stick or helmet, for a bobsledder, it might be their sled.
- F-** What do you call a piece of fabric that is usually flown and is used as a nation's symbol?
- G-** The first Olympic Games were held here in 776 B.C.
- H-** What do you call the gear that athletes wear to protect their heads?
- I-** What is the name of the sport that involves moving over the ice while performing jumps and spins?
- J-** A Lake Placid native, this man became the first Winter Olympic gold medalist by winning the 500-meter speed skating event in 1924 at Chamonix, France.
- K-** What is the name of the equipment athletes use to protect part of their legs to prevent injury?
